## A BILL

To bar Supreme Court decisions in certain Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act cases from citation.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. BARRING PPACA SUPREME COURT CASES**

4 **FROM CITATION.**

5 Under Article 3, Section 2, which allows Congress to  
6 provide exceptions and regulations for Supreme Court con-  
7 sideration of cases and controversies, the following cases  
8 are barred from citation for the purpose of precedence in  
9 all future cases after enactment: Nat'l Fed'n of Indep.  
10 Bus. v. Sebelius, 132 S. Ct. 2566, 2573, 183 L. Ed. 2d

1 450 (2012) and *King v. Burwell*, 135 S. Ct. 2480, 2485,  
2 192 L. Ed. 2d 483 (2015) and *Burwell v. Hobby Lobby*  
3 *Stores Inc.*, 134 S. Ct. 2751, 2782, 189 L. Ed. 2d 675  
4 (2014).
