## A BILL

To authorize additional appropriations for the family caregiver support program under the Older Americans Act of 1965, and for the National Clearinghouse for Long-Term Care Information, for fiscal years 2010, 2011, and 2012.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Elder Caregiver Sup-  
5 port and Information Enhancement Act of 2009”.

1 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS**  
2 **FOR THE FAMILY CAREGIVER SUPPORT PRO-**  
3 **GRAM UNDER THE OLDER AMERICANS ACT**  
4 **OF 1965.**

5 Section 303(e)(2) of the Older Americans Act of  
6 1965 (42 U.S.C. 3023(e)(2)) is amended by striking  
7 “\$173,000,000” and all that follows through “2021”, and  
8 inserting “and \$250,000,000 for each of the fiscal years  
9 2010, 2011, and 2012”.

10 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS**  
11 **FOR THE NATIONAL CLEARINGHOUSE FOR**  
12 **LONG-TERM CARE INFORMATION.**

13 There is authorized to be appropriated \$10,000,000  
14 for each of the fiscal years 2010, 2011, and 2012 for the  
15 operation of the National Clearinghouse for Long-Term  
16 Care Information established by the Secretary of Health  
17 and Human Services under section 6021(d) of Public Law  
18 109–171.
