Mr. BACON introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to require the submission of an annual budget submission display for operation and maintenance accounts of the Department of Defense, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. BUDGET JUSTIFICATION FOR OPERATION AND**
4 **MAINTENANCE.**

5 (a) SUBACTIVITY GROUP BY FUTURE YEARS.—Sec-
6 tion 233 of title 10, United States Code, is amended—

7 (1) by redesignating subsection (c) as sub-
8 section (e); and

1 (2) by inserting after subsection (b) the fol-
2 lowing new subsection (c):

3 “(c) SUBACTIVITY GROUPS.—The Secretary of De-
4 fense, in consultation with the Secretary of each of the
5 military departments, shall include in the materials sub-
6 mitted to Congress by the Secretary of Defense in support
7 of the President’s budget, in an unclassified format, the
8 total amount projected for each individual subactivity
9 group, as detailed in the future years defense program
10 pursuant to section 221 of this title.”

11 (b) BUDGET SUBMISSION DISPLAY.—Section 233 of
12 title 10, United States Code, is further amended by insert-
13 ing after subsection (c), as added by subsection (a), the
14 following new subsection:

15 “(d) BUDGET DISPLAY.—The Secretary of Defense,
16 in consultation with the Secretary of each of the military
17 departments, shall include in the O&M justification docu-
18 ments a budget display to provide for discussion and eval-
19 uation of the resources required to meet material readi-
20 ness objectives, as identified in the metrics required by
21 section 118 of this title, together with any associated risks
22 to the supply chain. For each major weapon system, by
23 designated mission design series, variant, or class, the
24 budget display required under this subsection for the
25 budget year shall include each of the following:

1 “(1) The material availability objective estab-
2 lished in accordance with the requirements of section
3 118 of this title.

4 “(2) The funds obligated by subactivity group
5 within the operation and maintenance accounts for
6 the second fiscal year preceding the budget year for
7 the purpose of achieving the material readiness ob-
8 jectives identified in accordance with section 118 of
9 this title.

10 “(3) The funds estimated to be obligated by
11 subactivity group within the operation and mainte-
12 nance accounts for the fiscal year preceding the
13 budget year for the purpose of achieving the mate-
14 rial readiness objectives identified in accordance with
15 section 118 of this title.

16 “(4) The funds budgeted and programmed
17 across the future years defense program within the
18 operation and maintenance accounts by subactivity
19 group for the purpose of achieving the material
20 readiness objectives identified in accordance with
21 section 118 of this title.

22 “(5) A narrative discussing the performance of
23 the Department against established material readi-
24 ness objectives for each major weapon system by
25 mission design series, variant, or class.”.

1 (c) IMPLEMENTATION DEADLINE.—The Secretary of
2 Defense shall ensure that the budget display requirements
3 required under the amendments made by this section are
4 included in the budget request for fiscal year 2023 and
5 all fiscal years thereafter.

6 (d) CONFORMING REPEAL.—Section 357 of the John
7 S. McCain National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal
8 Year 2019 (Public Law 115–232; 10 U.S.C. 221 note) is
9 repealed.

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
