Mr. STEUBE introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To require a report from the Director of the Secret Service
on illicit use of controlled substances at the Executive
Residence.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Helping Understand
5 Narcotics Traces at the Executive Residence Act of 2023”
6 or as the “HUNTER Act of 2023”.

7 **SEC. 2. REPORT ON ILLICIT USE OF CONTROLLED SUB-**
8 **STANCES IN THE WHITE HOUSE.**

9 Not later than 180 days after the date of enactment
10 of this Act, the Director of the Secret Service shall submit

1 a report to Congress on the illicit use of controlled sub-
2 stances present at the White House, which shall include—

3 (1) steps taken to avoid controlled substances
4 from coming into the White House;

5 (2) vulnerabilities where drugs can make its
6 way into the White House;

7 (3) a full account of the investigation into the
8 cocaine found at the White House in 2023; and

9 (4) recommendations on how Congress can pro-
10 vide oversight or resources to prevent illicit usage of
11 controlled substances in the Executive Branch.
