A BILL

To amend title 49, United States Code, to provide for limitations on the fees charged to passengers of air carriers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON FEES CHARGED TO PAS-**
4 **SENGERS OF AIR CARRIERS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (c) of section 44940
6 of title 49, United States Code, is amended to read as
7 follows:

8 “(c) LIMITATION ON FEE.—

9 “(1) AMOUNT.—Fees imposed under subsection

10 (a)(1) shall be \$5.60 per one-way trip in air trans-

1 portation or intrastate air transportation that origi-
2 nates at an airport in the United States, except that
3 the fee imposed per round trip shall not exceed
4 \$11.20.

5 “(2) DEFINITION OF ROUND TRIP.—In this
6 subsection, the term ‘round trip’ means a trip on an
7 air travel itinerary that terminates or has a stopover
8 at the origin point (or co-terminal).”.

9 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendment made by sub-
10 section (a) shall apply with respect to a trip in air trans-
11 portation or intrastate air transportation that is pur-
12 chased on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
