3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Educating Responsible
5 Future Hunters Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT ON ESEA FUNDING.**

7 Section 8526 of the Elementary and Secondary Edu-
8 cation Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7906) is amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (5), by adding “or” after the
2 semicolon;

3 (2) in paragraph (6), by striking “; or” and in-
4 serting a period; and

5 (3) by striking paragraph (7).
