Mr. HALL introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Army to revise the management plan for the conservation pool in Lake Texoma, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LAKE TEXOMA MANAGEMENT.**

4 (a) MANAGEMENT PLAN REVISION.—Notwith-
5 standing any other provision of law, the Secretary shall
6 revise the management plan for the conservation pool in
7 Lake Texoma to ensure that—

8 (1) the water surface elevation is maintained
9 between 619 and 614 mean sea level;

1 (2) if the water surface elevation is at or below
2 614 mean sea level, hydroelectric power generation
3 is only conducted upon a determination by the Sec-
4 retary, in consultation with the Lake Texoma Advi-
5 sory Committee, that there are emergency power
6 needs, including needs resulting from a natural dis-
7 aster; and

8 (3) additional water capacity resulting from the
9 revision under paragraph (1) may be made available
10 for allocation and, if allocated, district water sup-
11 pliers will be prioritized.

12 (b) TIMING.—The Secretary shall make the revisions
13 required under subsection (a) not later than 60 days after
14 the date of enactment of this Act.

15 (c) SECRETARY DEFINED.—In this section, the term
16 “Secretary” means the Secretary of the Army (acting
17 through the Chief of Engineers).

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
