Mr. CROWLEY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to provide
for a change in Medicare classification for certain hospitals.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CHANGE IN MEDICARE CLASSIFICATION FOR**
4 **CERTAIN HOSPITALS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (d)(1)(B) of section
6 1886 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395ww) is
7 amended—

8 (1) in clause (iv)—
9 (A) in subclause (I)—

3 (ii) by striking “or” at the end; and

4 (B) in subclause (II)—

5 (i) by striking “, or” at the end and
6 inserting a semicolon; and

10 (iii) in clause (v), by striking the
11 semicolon at the end and inserting “, or”.

12 (b) CONFORMING PAYMENT REFERENCES.—The sec-
13 ond sentence of subsection (d)(1)(B) of such section is
14 amended—

15 (1) by inserting “(as in effect as of such date)”
16 after “clause (iv)”; and

(c) APPLICATION.—

1 (1) IN GENERAL.—For cost-reporting periods
2 beginning on or after January 1, 2015, in the case
3 of an applicable hospital (as defined in paragraph
4 (3)), the following shall apply:

5 (A) Payment for inpatient operating costs
6 shall be made on the TEFRA basis in the man-
7 ner provided in section 412.526(c) of title 42,
8 Code of Federal Regulations (as in effect on
9 January 1, 2015).

10 (B) Payment for capital costs shall be
11 made in the manner provided by section
12 412.526(c)(4) of title 42, Code of Federal Reg-
13 ulations (as in effect on such date).

14 (C) Claims for payment for Medicare bene-
15 ficiaries who are discharged on or after January
16 1, 2015, shall be processed as claims which are
17 paid on a TEFRA payment basis as described
18 in section 412.526(c) of title 42, Code of Fed-
19 eral Regulations (as in effect on such date).

20 (2) ASSIGNMENT OF NEW PROVIDER NUM-
21 BER.—The Secretary of Health and Human Services
22 shall assign a new provider number for an applicable
23 hospital (as defined in paragraph (3)), effective for
24 its first cost-reporting period beginning on or after
25 the date of enactment of this Act.

9 (d) CONFORMING TECHNICAL AMENDMENT.—Sec-
10 tion 1899B(a)(2)(A)(iv) of the Social Security Act (42
11 U.S.C. 1395lll(a)(2)(A)(iv)) is amended by striking
12 “1886(d)(1)(B)(iv)(II)” and inserting
13 “1886(d)(1)(B)(vi)”.
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
