Ms. HERSETH SANDLIN introduced the following bill; which was referred to
the Committee on Energy and Commerce

A BILL

To improve choices for consumers for vehicles, and for other
purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Consumer Vehicle
5 Choice Act of 2010”.

6 **SEC. 2. ENSURING THE AVAILABILITY OF DUAL FUELED**
7 **AUTOMOBILES AND LIGHT DUTY TRUCKS.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 329 of title 49, United
9 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 32902
10 the following:

1 **“§ 32902A. Requirement to manufacture dual fueled**
 2 **automobiles and light duty trucks**

3 “(a) IN GENERAL.—For each model year listed in the
 4 following table, each manufacturer shall ensure that the
 5 percentage of automobiles and light duty trucks manufac-
 6 tured by the manufacturer for sale in the United States
 7 that are dual fueled automobiles and light duty trucks is
 8 not less than the percentage set forth for that model year
 9 in the following table:

“Model Year	Percentage
Model years 2011 and 2012	50 percent
Model year 2013 and each subsequent model year	90 percent.

10 “(b) EXCEPTION.—Subsection (a) shall not apply to
 11 automobiles or light duty trucks that operate only on elec-
 12 tricity.”.

13 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
 14 for chapter 329 of title 49, United States Code, is amend-
 15 ed by inserting after the item relating to section 32902
 16 the following:

“32902A. Requirement to manufacture dual fueled automobiles and light duty
 trucks.”.

17 (c) RULEMAKING.—Not later than 1 year after the
 18 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Trans-
 19 portation shall prescribe regulations to carry out the
 20 amendments made by this Act.
