3 SECTION 1. CERTAIN ROLLING BACKPACKS WITH A RE-4 MOVABLE BACKPACK OR DAYPACK.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:
