## A BILL

To provide for a one-year extension of the extended period of protections for members of uniformed services relating to mortgages, mortgage foreclosure, and eviction under the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stability for Service  
5 Members Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ONE-YEAR EXTENSION OF EXTENDED PERIOD OF**  
2 **PROTECTIONS FOR MEMBERS OF UNI-**  
3 **FORMED SERVICES RELATING TO MORT-**  
4 **GAGES, MORTGAGE FORECLOSURE, AND**  
5 **EVICTON UNDER SERVICEMEMBERS CIVIL**  
6 **RELIEF ACT.**

7 Section 710(d) of the Honoring America's Veterans  
8 and Caring for Camp Lejeune Families Act of 2012 (Pub-  
9 lic Law 112–154; 126 Stat. 1208; 50 U.S.C. App. 533  
10 note) is amended—

11 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “December  
12 31, 2014” and inserting “December 31, 2015”; and

13 (2) in paragraph (3), by striking “January 1,  
14 2015” and inserting “January 1, 2016”.
