Ms. Maxine Waters of California introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Financial Services

A BILL

To authorize appropriations for family unification vouchers for rental housing assistance, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Expanding Housing
- 5 Opportunities for Foster Youth Act of 2018".
- 6 SEC. 2. CONGRESSIONAL FINDINGS.
- 7 The Congress finds that—
- 8 (1) approximately 21,000 foster youth age out
- 9 of foster care each year according to the Administra-

- tion for Children and Families (ACF) of the Department of Health and Human Services;
- 3 (2) more than 1 out of every 4 foster youth who
 4 age out of foster care will experience homelessness
 5 by age 21, according to survey data from the Na6 tional Youth in Transition Database compiled by the
 7 ACF;
 - (3) access to safe, decent, and affordable housing is essential to helping foster youth successfully transition to adulthood;
 - (4) foster youth deserve a place to call home without being singled out for harmful requirements like work requirements as a condition of receiving housing assistance;
 - (5) the Family Unification Vouchers program of the Department of Housing and Urban Development provides housing assistance for foster youth along with case management, without work requirements; and
 - (6) there is insufficient funding for Family Unification Vouchers to serve all foster youth in need.
