A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to limit the authority of the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to deny the claim of a veteran for benefits under the laws administered by such Secretary on the sole basis that such veteran failed to appear for a medical examination associated with such claim.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Review Every Veterans*
5 *Claim Act of 2023”.*

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON DENIAL OF CLAIMS FOR BENEFITS**

7 **UNDER LAWS ADMINISTERED BY SECRETARY**
8 **OF VETERANS AFFAIRS ON SOLE BASIS THAT**
9 **VETERAN FAILED TO APPEAR FOR CERTAIN**
10 **MEDICAL EXAMINATION.**

11 *Subsection (d) of section 5103A of title 38, United*
12 *States Code, is amended—*

13 *(1) in the heading, by striking “COMPENSATION*
14 *CLAIMS” and inserting “CLAIMS FOR BENEFITS”;*

15 *(2) in paragraph (2), by striking “treat an ex-*
16 *amination or opinion as being necessary to make a*
17 *decision on a claim for purposes of” and inserting*
18 *“provide for a medical examination or obtain a med-*
19 *ical opinion under”; and*

20 *(3) by adding at the end the following new para-*
21 *graph:*

22 *“(3) If a veteran fails to appear for a medical exam-*
23 *ination provided by the Secretary in conjunction with a*
24 *claim for a benefit under a law administered by the Sec-*
25 *retary, the Secretary may not deny such claim on the sole*

1 basis that such veteran failed to appear for such medical
2 examination.”.

3 **SEC. 3. BOARD OF VETERANS' APPEALS: JURISDICTION;**

4 **ELEMENTS OF DECISIONS.**

5 (a) **JURISDICTION.**—Section 7104 of title 38, United
6 States Code, is amended, in subsection (a)—

7 (1) by inserting “(1)” before “All questions”; and
8 (2) by adding at the end the following new para-
9 graphs:

10 “(2) The Board shall determine, in the first instance,
11 whether the Board has jurisdiction regarding a matter.

12 “(3) If the Board, on its own initiative, raises a ques-
13 tion of a potential jurisdictional defect, the Board shall no-
14 tify the parties and allow the parties an opportunity to
15 respond.”.

16 (b) **ELEMENTS OF DECISIONS.**—Subsection (d) of such
17 section is amended as follows:

18 (1) In paragraph (2)—

19 (A) in subparagraphs (A) and (B), by strik-
20 ing “; and” both places it appears and inserting
21 a semicolon;

22 (B) by redesignating subparagraph (B), as
23 amended, as subparagraph (C); and

24 (C) by inserting, after subparagraph (A),
25 the following new subparagraph (B):

1 “(B) if such evidence was not considered as
2 described in subparagraph (A), identifying the
3 time when such evidence was received and the
4 provision of section 7113 of this title that estab-
5 lishes that such evidence may not be received at
6 such time; and”.

7 (2) By redesignating paragraph (3) as para-
8 graph (4).

9 (3) By inserting, after paragraph (2), the fol-
10 lowing new paragraph (3):

11 “(3) the written determination of the Board
12 whether the notice of disagreement was adequate and
13 timely filed under section 7105 of this title; and”.

14 (c) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 7105 of such
15 title is amended by striking subparagraph (C) of paragraph
16 (1) of subsection (b).

17 **SEC. 4. BOARD OF VETERANS' APPEALS PUBLICATION OF**
18 **DATES OF DOCKET ACTIVITY.**

19 Section 7107 of title 38, United States Code, is amend-
20 ed by adding at the end the following new subsection:

21 “(f) PUBLICATION OF EXPECTED ACTIONS.—(1) On a
22 weekly basis, for each docket, the Board shall publish, on
23 a website of the Department, notice of the docket dates of
24 the cases assigned to a Board member for a decision for
25 that week.

1 “(2) Each notice published under paragraph (1) shall
2 include a statement that an assignment described in such
3 paragraph does not require the Board to issue a decision
4 regarding the case during such week.

5 “(3) Paragraph (1) shall not apply to a case—

6 “(A) that has been advanced under subsection
7 (b); or

8 “(B) remanded by the United States Court of
9 Appeals for Veterans Claims.”.

10 **SEC. 5. MODIFICATION OF CERTAIN HOUSING LOAN FEES.**

11 The loan fee table in section 3729(b)(2) of title 38,
12 United States Code, is amended by striking “November 15,
13 2031” each place it appears and inserting “November 22,
14 2031”.

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
