Mr. CLARKE of Michigan (for himself and Mr. STIVERS) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To create jobs and promote fair trade by increasing duties on certain foreign goods imported into the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Creating Manufac-
5 turing Jobs and Promoting Fair Trade Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. POLYURETHANE SPONGES.**

7 Subheading 3921.13.50 of the Harmonized Tariff
8 Schedule of the United States is amended in the general
9 rate of duty column by striking “4.2%” and inserting
10 “6.5%”.

1 **SEC. 3. STEEL WOOL CLEANING PADS.**

2 Subheading 7323.10.00 of the Harmonized Tariff
3 Schedule of the United States is amended—

4 (1) in the general rate of duty column, by strik-
5 ing “Free” and inserting “20%”; and

6 (2) in the special rate of duty column, by in-
7 serting the following: “Free (A, AU, BH, CA, CL,
8 E, IL, J, JO, MA, MX, OM, P, PE, SG)”.

9 **SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

10 The amendments made by this Act shall apply to
11 goods entered, or withdrawn from warehouse for consump-
12 tion, on or after the 15th day after the date of the enact-
13 ment of this Act.

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
