A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to eliminate increases in the enrollment fee requirement for TRICARE Select for certain retired members of the Armed Forces, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Restore TRICARE Se-
5 lect Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF ENROLLMENT FEE REQUIREMENT**
2 **FOR TRICARE SELECT FOR CERTAIN RE-**
3 **TIRED MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (e) of section 1075 of
5 title 10, United States Code, is amended to read as fol-
6 lows:

7 “(e) EXCEPTIONS TO CERTAIN COST-SHARING
8 AMOUNTS FOR CERTAIN RETIRED BENEFICIARIES.—(1)
9 Notwithstanding subsection (d)—

10 “(A) the annual enrollment fee for TRICARE
11 Select for beneficiaries who are former members of
12 the uniformed services who retired before January 1,
13 2018, shall be \$0; and

14 “(B) subject to paragraph (2), the annual en-
15 rollment fee for TRICARE Select for beneficiaries
16 described in subsection (c)(2)(B) in the retired cat-
17 egory who are not described in subparagraph (A)
18 shall be \$150 for an individual and \$300 for a fam-
19 ily.

20 “(2) The modified enrollment fee established under
21 paragraph (1)(B) for beneficiaries described in subsection
22 (c)(2)(B) in the retired category shall not apply with re-
23 spect to the following beneficiaries:

24 “(A) Retired members and the family members
25 of such members covered by paragraph (1) of section
26 1086(c) of this title by reason of being retired under

1 chapter 61 of this title or being a dependent of such
2 a member.

3 “(B) Survivors covered by paragraph (2) of
4 such section 1086(c).”.

5 (b) REMOVAL OF ANNUAL INCREASE.—Subsection
6 (d)(2) of such section is amended by striking “, and the
7 amounts specified under paragraphs (1) and (2) of sub-
8 section (e),”.

9 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
10 this section shall apply to annual enrollment fees under
11 TRICARE Select under section 1075 of title 10, United
12 States Code, for coverage under TRICARE Select after
13 December 31, 2021.

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
