## A BILL

To authorize the Administrator of the Federal Emergency Management Agency to waive the 30-day waiting period for flood insurance policies purchased for private properties affected by wildfire on Federal lands.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR PRIVATE PROP-**  
4                               **ERTIES AFFECTED BY FLOODING FROM FED-**  
5                               **ERAL LANDS.**

6       Section 1306(e)(2) of the National Flood Insurance  
7       Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 4013(c)(2)) is amended—

1           (1) in subparagraph (A), by striking “or” at  
2 the end;

3           (2) in subparagraph (B), by striking the period  
4 at the end and inserting “; or”; and

5           (3) by adding at the end the following:

6           “(C) the initial purchase of flood insurance  
7 coverage for private property if—

8                   “(i) the Administrator determines  
9 that the property is affected by flooding on  
10 Federal land that is a result of, or is exac-  
11 erbated by, post-wildfire conditions, after  
12 consultation with an authorized employee  
13 of the Federal agency that has jurisdiction  
14 of the land on which the wildfire that  
15 caused the post-wildfire conditions oc-  
16 curred; and

17                   “(ii) the flood insurance coverage was  
18 purchased not later than 60 days after the  
19 fire containment date, as determined by  
20 the appropriate Federal employee, relating  
21 to the wildfire that caused the post-wildfire  
22 conditions described in clause (i).”.
