## A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Homeland Security to exempt from CFATS regulations certain propane tanks, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Propane Accessibility  
5 and Regulatory Relief Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXEMPTION FROM CFATS REGULATIONS OF CER-**  
2 **TAIN PROPANE TANKS.**

3       The Secretary of Homeland Security shall take such  
4 actions as may be necessary to exempt from any CFATS  
5 regulation (as such term is defined in section 2101 of the  
6 Homeland Security Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 621)) any pro-  
7 pane tank with a capacity of up to 126,000 pounds of pro-  
8 pane.
