Mr. NEGUSE introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Oversight and Reform

A BILL

To authorize the National Cyber Director to accept details from other elements of the Federal Government on non-reimbursable basis, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY FOR NATIONAL CYBER DIRECTOR**
4 **TO ACCEPT DETAILS ON NONREIMBURSABLE**
5 **BASIS.**

6 Section 1752(e) of the William M. (Mac) Thornberry
7 National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2021
8 (Public Law 116–283) is amended—

1 (1) by redesignating paragraphs (1) through
2 (8) as subparagraphs (A) through (H), respectively,
3 and indenting such subparagraphs two ems to the
4 right;

5 (2) in the matter before subparagraph (A), as
6 redesignated by paragraph (1), by striking “The Di-
7 rector may” and inserting the following:

8 “(1) IN GENERAL.—The Director may”;

9 (3) in paragraph (1)—

10 (A) as redesignated by paragraph (2), by
11 redesignating subparagraphs (C) through (H)
12 as subparagraphs (D) through (I), respectively;
13 and

14 (B) by inserting after subparagraph (B)
15 the following new subparagraph (C):

16 “(C) accept officers or employees of the
17 United States or member of the Armed Forces
18 on a detail from an element of the intelligence
19 community or from another element of the Fed-
20 eral Government on a nonreimbursable basis, as
21 jointly agreed to by the heads of the receiving
22 and detailing elements, for a period not to ex-
23 ceed three years;” and

24 (4) by adding at the end the following new
25 paragraph:

1 “(2) RULES OF CONSTRUCTION REGARDING DE-
2 TAILS.—Paragraph (1)(C) shall not be construed to
3 impose any limitation on any other authority for re-
4 imbursable or nonreimbursable details. A nonreim-
5 bursable detail made under such paragraph shall not
6 be considered an augmentation of the appropriations
7 of the receiving element of the Office of the National
8 Cyber Director.”.
