A BILL

To amend the FAA Reauthorization Act of 2018 to extend waiver of duplicate benefits limitation for certain payments to individuals in the event of a major disaster, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Duplications of Bene-
5 fits Victims Relief Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. WAIVER OF DUPLICATE BENEFITS.**

7 Section 1210(a) of the FAA Reauthorization Act of
8 2018 (Public Law 115–254) is amended—

9 (1) in paragraph (3) by striking “between Jan-
10 uary 1, 2016, and December 31, 2021” and insert-
11 ing “during the period beginning on January 1,
12 2016, and ending on the date on which the provision
13 contained in such amendment is struck pursuant to
14 paragraph (4)”;

15 (2) in paragraph (4) by striking “5” and insert-
16 ing “10”;

17 (3) by redesignating paragraph (5) as para-
18 graph (6); and

19 (4) by inserting after paragraph (4) the fol-
20 lowing:

21 “(5) PROHIBITION ON INCOME THRESHOLD.—

22 In carrying out the amendment made by paragraph
23 (1), no income threshold may be applied to limit the
24 eligibility of a recipient from qualifying for a waiver
25 under the amendment made by such paragraph.”.
