A BILL

To revise the standards for eligibility for community development block grant disaster recovery grants, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISASTER RECOV-**
4 **ERY GRANTS.**

5 In making any determination of whether any ZIP
6 Code is a most impacted and distressed area for purposes
7 of eligibility for a formula allocation with amounts made
8 available under title I of the Housing and Community De-
9 velopment Act of 1974 (42 U.S.C. 5301 et seq.) for dis-
10 aster recovery, the Secretary of Housing and Urban Devel-

1 opment may not establish a minimum threshold dollar
2 amount relating to serious unmet housing need for an area
3 to be considered as having suffered sufficient concentrated
4 damages, but shall consider any ZIP Code for which the
5 median household income is less than 75 percent of the
6 national median household income as having suffered such
7 sufficient concentrated damages.
