A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to maintain certain telehealth flexibilities relating to provider privacy under the Medicare program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Medicare Telehealth
5 Privacy Act of 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. MAINTAINING CERTAIN TELEHEALTH FLEXIBILI-**
2 **TIES RELATING TO PROVIDER PRIVACY**
3 **UNDER THE MEDICARE PROGRAM.**

4 Section 1834(m) of the Social Security Act (42
5 U.S.C. 1395m(m)) is amended by adding at the end the
6 following new paragraph:

7 “(10) ENSURING PHYSICIAN AND PRACTI-
8 TIONER PRIVACY.—In the case of a physician or
9 practitioner who elects to furnish telehealth services
10 at a distant site that is the home of such physician
11 or practitioner, if the Secretary requires such physi-
12 cian or practitioner to include the address of such
13 home on any enrollment form of such physician or
14 practitioner under this title (or requires such physi-
15 cian or practitioner to bill for such services using
16 such address), the Secretary may not make such ad-
17 dress available to the public in any manner.”.

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
