A BILL

To realign L-29 at full Federal expense for the Miccosukee Tribe to expand the area for the Tigertail camp, which is a residential area.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Tigertail Historical
5 Tree Island Repatriation Act of 2023”.

6 **SEC. 2. CENTRAL AND SOUTHERN FLORIDA PROJECT,**
7 **MODIFICATION OF THE L-29 LEVEE.**

8 In consultation with the South Florida Water Man-
9 agement District, the Secretary of the Army is authorized

1 to design and construct, at full Federal expense, modifica-
2 tions to the L-29 Levee component of the Central and
3 Southern Florida Project, to realign a portion of the L-
4 29 Section 3 Levee Segment to reconfigure the levee in
5 the vicinity of the Miccosukee Tribe of Indians of Florida's
6 Tigertail Camp, as expanded pursuant to the Miccosukee
7 Tribe of Indians of Florida's lease from the South Florida
8 Water Management District. Any necessary lands, ease-
9 ments, rights-of-way, relocations, and dredge disposal
10 areas (LERRDs) for such a modification would be pro-
11 vided by the South Florida Water Management District.
