A BILL

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMERICAN INDIANS BORN IN CANADA OR THE**
4 **UNITED STATES.**

5 Section 289 of the Immigration and Nationality Act
6 (8 U.S.C. 1359) is amended—

1 (1) by inserting after “born in Canada” the fol-
2 lowing: “or the United States”; and

3 (2) by inserting after “but such right shall ex-
4 tend only to persons” the following: “who are mem-
5 bers, or are eligible to be members, of a Federally
6 recognized Indian tribe in the United States or Can-
7 ada, or”.
