3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Minimum Staffing of
5 Air Traffic Controllers Act of 2013”.

1 **SEC. 2. MINIMUM STAFFING OF AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL-**
2 **TERS.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—The Secretary of Transportation
4 shall take such actions as may be necessary to ensure that,
5 at a covered airport, not fewer than 2 air traffic control-
6 lers are on duty and physically situated within the air-
7 port’s air traffic control room or tower at all times during
8 periods of airfield operations.

9 (b) **COVERED AIRPORT.**—In this section, the term
10 “covered airport” means an airport in the United States
11 at which scheduled commercial air carrier operations are
12 provided regularly.
