Mr. LUETKEMEYER (for himself and Mr. SESSIONS) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and in addition to the Committee on Small Business, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

To amend the FAST Act to ensure that certain veteran small businesses are eligible for funding as small business concerns.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Service Disabled Vet-
5 eran Infrastructure Investment Parity Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. SMALL BUSINESS CONCERNS.**

7 Section 1101(b) of the FAST Act (Public Law 114–
8 94) is amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (2) by adding at the end the
2 following:

3 “(C) SERVICE-DISABLED VETERAN-OWNED
4 SMALL BUSINESS.—The term ‘service-disabled
5 veteran-owned small business’ has the meaning
6 given the term ‘small business concern owned
7 and controlled by service-disabled veterans’ in
8 section 3(q) of the Small Business Act (15
9 U.S.C. 632(q)).”;

10 (2) in paragraph (3), by inserting before the pe-
11 riod the following: “and service-disabled veteran-
12 owned small businesses”; and

13 (3) in paragraph (4)(B)—

14 (A) in clause (ii) by striking “and” at the
15 end;

16 (B) in clause (iii) by striking the period at
17 the end and inserting “; and”; and

18 (C) by adding at the end the following:

19 “(iv) service-disabled veteran-owned
20 small businesses.”.
