A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Preserving Seniors’
5 Access to Physicians Act of 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. INCREASING SUPPORT FOR PHYSICIANS AND**
2 **OTHER PRACTITIONERS IN ADJUSTING TO**
3 **MEDICARE PAYMENT CHANGES.**
