# A BILL

To amend the Department of Housing and Urban Development Act to require the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development to testify on an annual basis before the Congress.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2   *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3   **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       *This Act may be cited as the “HUD Accountability*  
5   *Act of 2024”.*

6   **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT TO TESTIFY.**

7       *Section 7 of the Department of Housing and Urban*  
8   *Development Act (42 U.S.C. 3535) is amended by adding*  
9   *at the end the following new subsection:*

10       “(u) ANNUAL TESTIMONY.—During the 5-year period  
11   beginning on the date of the enactment of this subsection,  
12   the Secretary shall appear before the Committee on Finan-  
13   cial Services of the House of Representatives and the Com-  
14   mittee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs of the Sen-  
15   ate at an annual hearing and present testimony regarding  
16   the operations of the Department during the preceding year,  
17   including regarding the following topics:

18       “(1) The progress made by the Federal Govern-  
19   ment in ending the affordable housing and homeless-  
20   ness crises.

21       “(2) The current programs and operations of the  
22   Department.

23       “(3) The physical condition of all public housing  
24   and other housing assisted by the Department.

1           “(4) *The financial health of the mortgage insur-*  
2           *ance funds of the FHA.*

3           “(5) *Oversight by the Department of grantees*  
4           *and sub-grantees for purposes of preventing waste,*  
5           *fraud, and abuse.*

6           “(6) *The effects of the changes made in 2017 to*  
7           *the Federal income tax deduction for State and local*  
8           *taxes (known as the SALT deduction) on the cost of*  
9           *homeownership in the United States, except that this*  
10          *paragraph shall not apply at any time that such tax*  
11          *deduction is in effect in the same form and manner*  
12          *as immediately before such 2017 changes.*

13          “(7) *Other ongoing activities of the Department,*  
14          *as appropriate.”.*
