A BILL

To amend the Controlled Substances Act to provide for the scheduling of tianeptine as a schedule III substance, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Scheduling Tianeptine
5 and Analogues Now to Defend Against Emerging Opioids
6 Act” or the “STAND Against Emerging Opioids Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. SCHEDULING OF TIANEPTINE.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 202(c) of the Controlled
3 Substances Act (21 U.S.C. 812(c)) is amended by adding
4 at the end of schedule III the following:

5 “(f) Tianeptine, including its analogues, salts, iso-
6 mers, and salts of isomers.”.

7 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
8 subsection (a) shall become effective on the date that is
9 90 days after the date of enactment of this Act.

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
