## A BILL

To prohibit the Federal Government from removing or altering a barrier, fence, barbed wire, or obstacle constructed by a State along the United States border for the purpose of preventing unlawful crossings, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2       This Act may be cited as the “Restricting Adminis-  
3 tration Zealots from Obliging Raiders Act” or the  
4 “RAZOR Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION.**

6       No department or agency of the Federal Government  
7 may remove or alter a barrier, fence, barbed wire, or ob-  
8 stacle constructed by a State along the United States bor-  
9 der for the purpose of preventing unlawful crossings.
