A BILL

To amend the Occupational Safety and Health Act to prohibit the Secretary from enforcing any drug or vaccine mandate, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No OSHA Authority
5 to Mandate Vaccines Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON DRUG AND VACCINE MANDATES.**

2 Section 4(b) of the Occupational Safety and Health
3 Act (29 U.S.C. 653(b)) is amended by adding at the end
4 the following:

5 “(4) Nothing in this Act shall be construed to
6 provide the Secretary with the authority to require
7 any drug (as defined in section 201(g)(1) of the
8 Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act) or vaccine
9 or other biological product (as defined in section
10 351(i)(1) of the Public Health Service Act) to be ad-
11 ministered to any employee.”.
