## A BILL

To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act with respect to the issuance of nonimmigrant status under section 101(a)(15)(H)(i)(b).

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “American Worker Pro-  
5 tection Act of 2024”.

1 **SEC. 2. ISSUANCE OF NONIMMIGRANT STATUS UNDER H-**

2 **1B.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 214(g) of the Immigra-  
4 tion and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1184(g)) is amended  
5 by adding at the end the following:

6 “(12) Aliens who are subject to the numerical  
7 limitations of paragraph (1)(A) shall be issued visas  
8 (or otherwise provided nonimmigrant status) in the  
9 order of the highest compensation rate included in  
10 the application for such visa to the lowest compensa-  
11 tion rate.”.

12 (b) **RULES.**—Prior to the issuance of a visa or non-  
13 immigrant status under section 101(a)(15)(H)(i)(b) for  
14 the first fiscal year following the date of the enactment  
15 of this Act, the Secretary of Homeland Security shall issue  
16 any rules necessary to carry out section 214(g)(9) of the  
17 Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1184(g)(9)),  
18 as amended by this Act.
