A BILL

To reauthorize the Congressional Award Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Congressional Award
5 Program Reauthorization Act of 2024”.

6 **SEC. 2. TERMINATION.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 108 of the Congressional
8 Award Act (2 U.S.C. 808) is amended by striking “Octo-
9 ber 1, 2024” and inserting “October 1, 2029”.

10 (b) RETROACTIVE EFFECTIVE DATE.—If this Act is
11 enacted after October 1, 2024, the amendment made by

1 subsection (a) shall take effect as if enacted on October
2 1, 2024.

3 **SEC. 3. OTHER AMENDMENTS.**

4 Section 102 of the Congressional Award Act (2
5 U.S.C. 802) is amended—

6 (1) in subsection (a), by striking “Each medal
7 shall consist of gold-plate over bronze, rhodium over
8 bronze, or bronze and shall be struck in accordance
9 with subsection (f).”; and

10 (2) in subsection (f)(1), in the second sentence,
11 by striking “Subject to subsection (a), the” and in-
12 serting “The”.
