A BILL

To amend the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act to require a warning label advising that the effects of mifepristone can be counteracted, to amend the Public Health Service Act to establish a hotline to provide information to women seeking to counteract the effects of mifepristone, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Second Chance for
5 Moms Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. MIFEPRISTONE WARNING LABEL AND HOTLINE.**

2 (a) WARNING LABEL.—

3 (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 502 of the Federal
4 Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. 352) is
5 amended by adding at the end the following:

6 “(hh) If it is the drug mifepristone, and its labeling
7 does not bear the following statement printed in con-
8 spicuous text: ‘WARNING: Medical evidence suggests that
9 the abortifacient effects of mifepristone can be counter-
10 acted by natural progesterone, which can increase the
11 chance of fetal survival. The American Society for Repro-
12 ductive Medicine has determined that natural progester-
13 one is safe in the first trimester of pregnancy. For more
14 information, call [_____].’ (with the blank filled in to
15 refer to the appropriate number for the hotline under sec-
16 tion 1009 of the Public Health Service Act).”.

17 (2) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Section 502(hh) of the
18 Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (as added by
19 paragraph (1)) applies beginning on the date that is
20 6 months after the date of enactment of this Act.

21 (b) HOTLINE.—Title X of the Public Health Service
22 Act (42 U.S.C. 300 et seq.) is amended by adding at the
23 end the following:

1 **“SEC. 1009. HOTLINE FOR REVERSAL OF EFFECTS OF**
2 **MIFEPRISTONE.**

3 “The Secretary shall establish or maintain, directly
4 or by grant or contract, a toll-free hotline to provide sup-
5 port for 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, for women seeking
6 to reverse the effects of the drug mifepristone.”.

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
