A BILL

To amend the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States to provide for permanent duty-free treatment on imports of basketballs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT DUTY-FREE TREATMENT ON IM-**
4 **PORTS OF BASKETBALLS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 95 of the Harmonized
6 Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended by insert-
7 ing in numerical sequence the following new subheading,
8 with the article description having the same degree of in-
9 dentation as the article description for subheading
10 9506.62.40:

“9506.62.70	Basketballs	Free		30%”.
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1 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—

2 (1) Chapter 95 of the Harmonized Tariff
3 Schedule of the United States, as amended by sub-
4 section (a), is further amended by redesignating sub-
5 heading 9506.62.80 as subheading 9506.62.81.

6 (2) Subchapter II of chapter 99 of the Har-
7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
8 amended by striking headings 9902.17.75,
9 9902.17.76, and 9902.17.77.

10 (3) Note 20(s)(i) to subchapter III of chapter
11 99 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United
12 States is amended by striking “9506.62.80” and by
13 inserting “9506.62.70” and “9506.62.81”.

14 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
15 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn
16 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
17 after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
