A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Keeping Violent Offend-*
5 *ers Off Our Streets Act”.*

6 **SEC. 2. FRAUD IN CONNECTION WITH POSTING BAIL.**

7 *Section 1033(f)(1)(A) of title 18, United States Code,*
8 *is amended by inserting before the comma the following:*
9 *“(including the posting of monetary bail, criminal bail*
10 *bonds, and Federal immigration bail bonds)”.*
