A BILL

To require States and local educational agencies to report on the achievement of military-connected students in annual report cards under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Helping Military Chil-
5 dren Succeed in Schools Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPORTING ON MILITARY-CONNECTED STUDENTS**
2 **IN ANNUAL REPORT CARDS.**

3 Section 1111(h)(1)(C) of the Elementary and Sec-
4 ondary Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 6311(h)(1)(C))
5 is amended—

6 (1) by striking “and” at the end of clause (vii);

7 (2) by striking the period at the end of clause
8 (viii) and inserting “; and”; and

9 (3) by adding at the end the following:

10 “(ix) not later than the beginning of
11 the 2015–2016 school year, information on
12 the number of military-connected students
13 (students who are a dependent of a mem-
14 ber of the Armed Forces, including reserve
15 components thereof) in the State and how
16 such military-dependent students achieved
17 on the State academic assessments de-
18 scribed in subsection (b)(2) compared to
19 all students in the State.”.

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
