SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON NEW NATIONAL MONUMENTS IN MONTANA WITHOUT CONGRESSIONAL AP PROVAL.

4 This proviso of the last sentence of the first section
5 of the Act of September 14, 1950 (64 Stat. 849, chapter
6 950; 16 U.S.C. 431a), is amended by inserting "or Mon7 tana" after "Wyoming".

8 SEC. 3. PROHIBITION ON NEW WILD LANDS IN MONTANA 9 WITHOUT CONGRESSIONAL APPROVAL.

The Bureau of Land Management shall not implement, administer, or enforce Secretarial Order No. 3310,
issued by the Secretary of the Interior on December 22,
2010, on any lands in Montana, except by Congressional
approval.
