Mr. JOHNSON of Ohio (for himself and Mr. YARMUTH) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To amend the National Trails System Act to extend the Lewis and Clark National Historic Trail, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Eastern Legacy Exten-
5 sion Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF LEWIS AND CLARK NATIONAL HIS-**
7 **TORIC TRAIL.**

8 (a) EXTENSION.—Section 5(a)(6) of the National
9 Trails System Act (16 U.S.C. 1244(a)(6)) is amended, in
10 the first sentence—

1 (1) by striking “three thousand seven hundred”
2 and inserting “4,900”;

3 (2) by striking “Wood River, Illinois,” and in-
4 serting “the Ohio River in Pittsburgh, Pennsyl-
5 vania,”; and

6 (3) by striking “maps identified as, ‘Vicinity
7 Map, Lewis and Clark Trail’ study report dated
8 April 1977” and inserting “the map entitled Lewis
9 and Clark National Historic Trail Authorized Trail
10 Including Proposed Eastern Legacy Extension,
11 dated April 2018, and numbered 648/143721”.

12 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
13 subsection (a) take effect on the date that is 60 days after
14 the date of enactment of this Act.
