To rescind and transfer funds available for the Office of the Director of the National Institutes of Health to accounts for pediatric cancer research, awareness, and survivorship, to reduce the deficit, and for other purposes.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Fighting Cancer in
5 Children Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. TRANSFER AND RESCISSION OF AMOUNTS AVAIL-**
2 **ABLE FOR OFFICE OF THE DIRECTOR OF NIH.**

3 Of the unobligated amounts available for “National
4 Institutes of Health—Office of the Director” in Public
5 Law 117–103—

6 (1) \$30,000,000 is transferred to, and merged
7 with, amounts available to carry out section 417E of
8 the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 285a–11;
9 relating to pediatric cancer research, awareness, and
10 survivorship); and

11 (2) \$30,000,000 is hereby rescinded.
