A BILL

To prohibit the use of Federal funds to install permanent fencing around the United States Supreme Court Building or grounds.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Fencing at the
5 United States Supreme Court Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITING USE OF FUNDS FOR PERMANENT**
7 **FENCING AROUND UNITED STATES SUPREME**
8 **COURT BUILDING OR GROUNDS.**

9 No Federal funds may be used to install permanent
10 fencing around—

1 (1) the perimeter of the United States Supreme
2 Court Building; or

3 (2) the perimeter of the Supreme Court
4 grounds, or any portion thereof, described in section
5 6101(b) of title 40, United States Code.
