AN ACT

To amend title 38, United States Code, to establish in the Department of Veterans Affairs an Office of Food Security, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Food Security for All
- 3 Veterans Act".
- 4 SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS
- 5 AFFAIRS OFFICE OF FOOD SECURITY.
- 6 Chapter 3 of title 38, United States Code, is amended
- 7 by adding at the end the following new section (and con-
- 8 forming the table of sections at the beginning of such
- 9 chapter accordingly):

10 "§ 325. Office of Food Security

- 11 "(a) Establishment.—There is in the Department
- 12 an office to be known as the 'Office of Food Security'.
- 13 There is at the head of the Office a Director, which shall
- 14 be a career position.
- 15 "(b) Responsibilities.—(1) The Director of the Of-
- 16 fice of Food Security shall carry out the following respon-
- 17 sibilities:
- 18 "(A) To provide information to veterans con-
- 19 cerning the availability of, and eligibility require-
- 20 ments for Federal nutrition assistance programs.
- 21 "(B) To collaborate with other program offices
- of the Department, including the Homeless Pro-
- 23 grams Office and the Office of Tribal Government
- Relations, to develop and implement policies and
- procedures to identify and treat veterans at-risk or
- 26 experiencing food insecurity.

"(C) To collaborate with the Secretary of Agriculture and the Secretary of Defense on food insecurity among veterans, including by collaborating with
the Secretaries to develop materials related to food
insecurity for the Transition Assistance Program
curriculum and other transition-related resources.

- "(D) To develop and provide training, including training that may count towards continuing education or licensure requirements, for social workers, dietitians, chaplains, and other clinicians on how to assist veterans with enrollment in Federal nutrition assistance programs, including the supplemental nutrition assistance program and the special supplemental nutrition program for women, infants, and children established by section 17 of the Child Nutrition Act of 1966 (42 U.S.C. 1786).
- "(E) To issue guidance to Department medical centers on how to collaborate with their State and local offices administering the supplemental nutrition assistance program.
- "(2) In carrying out the responsibilities under para-22 graph (1), the Director shall consult with and provide 23 technical assistance to the heads of other Federal depart-24 ments and agencies, including the Department of Agri-

- 1 culture, Department of Defense, Department of Interior,
- 2 and Department of Labor.
- 3 "(c) Annual Report on Food Insecurity.—The
- 4 Secretary of Veterans Affairs, in consultation with the
- 5 Secretary of Agriculture, shall submit to the Committees
- 6 on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate and House of Rep-
- 7 resentatives an annual report on veteran food insecurity.
- 8 Each such report shall include data on the following:
- 9 "(1) The socioeconomic, ethnic, and racial char-
- 10 acteristics of veterans experiencing food insecurity,
- disaggregated by State in which the veteran is lo-
- 12 cated.
- 13 "(2) Native American veterans experiencing
- 14 food insecurity.
- 15 "(3) Specific interventions for veterans who
- screen positive for food insecurity.
- 17 "(4) Eligibility screenings for participation in
- the supplemental nutrition assistance program com-
- 19 pleted by personnel of the Department of Veterans
- Affairs.
- 21 "(5) The number of applications for participa-
- tion in the supplemental nutrition assistance pro-
- gram completed with assistance from personnel of
- the Department.

- 1 "(6) Changes, as a result of participation in the 2 supplemental nutrition assistance program, in the 3 number of food insecure veteran households.
- "(7) Coordination efforts between State agencies and Department facilities located in that State regarding outreach to veterans to participate in the supplemental nutrition assistance program.
- 8 "(d) Definitions.—In this section:
- 9 "(1) The terms 'Native American' and 'Native 10 American veteran' have the meanings given those 11 terms in section 3765 of this title.
- "(2) The terms 'State agency' and 'supplemental nutrition assistance program' have the meanings given those terms in section 3 of the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2012).".

16 SEC. 3. DETERMINATION OF BUDGETARY EFFECTS.

- 17 The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of
- 18 complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010,
- 19 shall be determined by reference to the latest statement
- 20 titled "Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation" for this
- 21 Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record
- 22 by the Chairman of the House Budget Committee, pro-

- 1 vided that such statement has been submitted prior to the
- 2 vote on passage.
