A BILL

To require the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration to update certain regulations to allow for expanded use of lap held child restraints during flights, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Safety for Our Babies
5 Act of 2024”.

6 **SEC. 2. LAP HELD CHILD RESTRAINTS.**

7 Not later than 90 days after the date of enactment
8 of this Act, the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Ad-

1 ministration shall update sections 91.107, 121.311,
2 125.211, and 135.128 of title 14, Code of Federal Regula-
3 tions, and any such other related regulations as the Ad-
4 ministrator determines appropriate, to remove any prohi-
5 bition, restriction, or condition on an adult accompanying
6 a child under the age of 2 on an aircraft choosing to secure
7 such child in a lap held child restraint approved and pro-
8 vided by such adult during movement on the surface, take-
9 off, or landing.
