## A BILL

To amend the Child Nutrition Act of 1966 to provide vouchers for the purchase of educational books for infants and children participating in the special supplemental nutrition program for women, infants, and children under that Act.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Access to Books for
- 5 Children Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. FINDINGS.
- 7 The Congress finds the following:

- 1 (1) Reading to a child plays a crucial role in 2 the development of the child's brain from the earliest 3 years. 4 (2) According to a 1995 study by the National
  - (2) According to a 1995 study by the National Commission on Reading, reading aloud to a child is the single most important tool for developing literacy skills.
    - (3) A child who is not introduced to books and early literacy practices is more than three times as likely to drop out of school as a child who is introduced to books and early literacy practices.
- 12 (4) The American Academy of Pediatrics rec-13 ommends daily reading to a child beginning when 14 the child is just 6 months old and recommends that 15 pediatricians prescribe reading activities and other 16 instruction to parents during well-child visits.

- 22 "(r) Vouchers for Purchase of Educational
- 23 Books for Infants and Children.—
- 24 "(1) IN GENERAL.—In carrying out the pro-
- 25 gram under this section, the Secretary shall provide

grants to local agencies for the purpose of providing
vouchers to women participating in the program for
the purchase of educational books for the infants
and children of such women.

- "(2) Additional requirements.—In providing vouchers pursuant to paragraph (1), a local agency shall comply with the following requirements:
- "(A) A woman may receive not more than
  1 voucher (irrespective of the number of infants
  or children of the woman).
- 11 "(B) The amount of a voucher may not ex-12 ceed \$5.
  - "(3) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—
    There are authorized to be appropriated to the Secretary \$11,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2012 through 2014 to carry out this subsection, of which not more than \$1,000,000 may be used for administrative costs. Amounts made available under this paragraph shall remain available until expended.".
