## AN ACT

To direct the Director of the United States Secret Service to apply the same standards for determining the number of agents required to protect Presidents, Vice Presidents, and major Presidential and Vice Presidential candidates, and for other purposes.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Enhanced Presidential  
3 Security Act of 2024”.

4 **SEC. 2. UNIFORM STANDARDS FOR SECRET SERVICE PRO-**  
5 **TECTION OF PRESIDENTS, VICE PRESIDENTS,**  
6 **AND MAJOR PRESIDENTIAL AND VICE PRESI-**  
7 **DENTIAL CANDIDATES.**

8 The Director of the United States Secret Service  
9 shall apply the same standards for determining the num-  
10 ber of agents required to protect Presidents, Vice Presi-  
11 dents, and major Presidential and Vice Presidential can-  
12 didates.

13 **SEC. 3. REPORT.**

14 Not later than 180 days after the date of enactment  
15 of this Act, the Director of the United States Secret Serv-  
16 ice shall conduct a comprehensive review of the provision  
17 of protection by the Secret Service for Presidents, Vice  
18 Presidents, former Presidents, and major Presidential and  
19 Vice Presidential candidates, and submit to the Committee  
20 on the Judiciary of the House of Representatives and the  
21 Committee on the Judiciary of the Senate a report that  
22 includes the findings from such review, along with any rec-  
23 ommendations for improving the provision of protection.

24 **SEC. 4. DEFINITION.**

25 In this Act, the term “major Presidential and Vice  
26 Presidential candidates” has the meaning given such term

1 in section 3056 of title 18, United States Code, and in-  
2 cludes any other Presidential or Vice Presidential can-  
3 didate for whom the President has otherwise authorized  
4 the Secret Service to protect.
