A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to prohibit 501(c)(3) organizations from providing direct funding to State attorneys general.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Ensuring State Attor-
5 ney General Accountability Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. 501(c)(3) ORGANIZATIONS PROHIBITED FROM PRO-**
2 **VIDING DIRECT FUNDING TO STATE ATTOR-**
3 **NEYS GENERAL.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal
5 Revenue Code of 1986 is amended—

6 (1) by striking “and which does not partici-
7 pate” and inserting “which does not participate”,
8 and

9 (2) by striking the period at the end and insert-
10 ing “, and which does not provide direct funding to
11 any attorney general of a State for the purpose of
12 a lawsuit, investigation, or remuneration of per-
13 sonnel.”.

14 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by
15 this subsection shall apply to funding provided in taxable
16 years beginning after December 31, 2024.
