3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Think Differently
5 About Building Accessibility Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. GAO REPORT.**

7 Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment
8 of this Act, the Comptroller General of the United States
9 shall report to the Committee on Transportation and In-
10 frastructure of the House of Representatives and the Com-
11 mittee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate
12 on the compliance under the Architectural Barriers Act
13 of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 4151 et seq.) of all office buildings
14 under the jurisdiction, custody, or control of the General
15 Services Administration.
