Mr. GREEN of Texas introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Oversight and Accountability, and in addition to the Committee on Education and the Workforce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

To provide for the issuance of a Prince Hall Commemorative Stamp.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Original Prince Hall
5 Commemorative Stamp Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PRINCE HALL COMMEMORATIVE SEMIPOSTAL**
7 **STAMP.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—The United States Postal Service
9 shall issue a semipostal stamp (hereinafter in this Act re-

1 ferred to as the “Prince Hall Commemorative Stamp”) in
2 accordance with this section.

3 (b) TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The issuance and sale
4 of the Prince Hall Commemorative Stamp shall be gov-
5 erned by the provisions of section 416 of title 39, United
6 States Code, and regulations issued under such section.

7 (c) DISPOSITION OF PROCEEDS.—

8 (1) IN GENERAL.—All amounts becoming avail-
9 able from the sale of the Prince Hall Commemora-
10 tive Stamp (as determined under section 416(d) of
11 such title 39) shall be transferred to the Department
12 of Education, for purposes of making Federal Pell
13 Grants under section 401 of the Higher Education
14 Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1070a), through payments
15 which shall be made at least twice a year.

16 (2) PROCEEDS NOT TO BE OFFSET.—In accord-
17 ance with section 416(d)(4) of such title 39,
18 amounts becoming available from the sale of the
19 Prince Hall Commemorative Stamp (as so deter-
20 mined) shall not be taken into account in any deci-
21 sion relating to the level of appropriations or other
22 Federal funding to be furnished in any year to the
23 Department of Education.

1 (d) DURATION.—The Prince Hall Commemorative
2 Stamp shall be made available to the public for during
3 the two-year period beginning on January 1, 2025.

4 (e) DEFINITION.—For purposes of this Act, the term
5 “semipostal stamp” refers to a stamp described in section
6 416(a)(1) of title 39, United States Code.
