A BILL

To require the Federal Communications Commission to amend the rules of the Commission to include a shark attack as an event for which a wireless emergency alert may be transmitted, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as “Lulu’s Law”.

5 **SEC. 2. WIRELESS EMERGENCY ALERTS.**

6 (a) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term “Alert
7 Message” has the meaning given the term in section

1 10.10(a) of title 47, Code of Federal Regulations, or any
2 successor regulation.

3 (b) REQUIREMENT.—Not later than 60 days after the
4 date of enactment of this Act, the Federal Communica-
5 tions Commission shall amend part 10 of title 47, Code
6 of Federal Regulations, or any successor regulations, to
7 provide that a shark attack is an event for which an Alert
8 Message may be transmitted under that part (or suc-
9 cessor, if applicable).
