A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to prohibit Department of Defense special Government employees from obligating or expending Federal funds while carrying out their official duties, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Preventing Corruption
5 in Advisory Roles Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITING DOD SPECIAL GOVERNMENT EM-**
2 **PLOYEES FROM SPENDING FEDERAL FUNDS.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Chapter 81 of title 10, United
4 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 1589
5 the following:

6 **“§ 1590. Prohibition on special Government employ-**
7 **ees from obligations or expending Fed-**
8 **eral funds**

9 “Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a spe-
10 cial Government employee (as that term is defined in sec-
11 tion 202(a) of title 18) occupying a position in the Depart-
12 ment of Defense may not, while carrying out the official
13 duties of the employee’s position, obligate or expend any
14 Federal funds.”.

15 (b) **CLERICAL AMENDMENT.**—The table of sections
16 for such chapter is amended by inserting after the item
17 relating to section 1589 the following:

“1590. Prohibition on special Government employees from obligations or expend-
ing Federal funds.”.
