Mrs. STEEL (for herself, Mr. CONNOLLY, and Mrs. RADEWAGEN) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs

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## A BILL

To require certain reports and briefings relating to North Korea.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPORTS AND BRIEFINGS RELATING TO**  
4 **NORTH KOREA.**

5 (a) ANNUAL REPORT.—The President shall submit  
6 to Congress on annual basis a report on the matters de-  
7 scribed in each of following:

8 (1) Section 203(e) of the North Korea Sanc-  
9 tions and Policy Enhancement Act of 2016 (22  
10 U.S.C. 9223(e); relating to arms trafficking involv-  
11 ing North Korea).

1           (2) Section 205(a)(1) of the North Korea Sanc-  
2           tions and Policy Enhancement Act of 2016 (22  
3           U.S.C. 9225(a)(1); relating to operators of foreign  
4           sea ports and airports that fail to inspect cargo to  
5           or from North Korea).

6           (3) Section 316 of the Korean Interdiction and  
7           Modernization of Sanctions Act (Public Law 115–  
8           44; relating to report on cooperation between North  
9           Korea and Iran).

10          (b) SEMI-ANNUAL REPORT.—The President shall  
11          submit to Congress on a semi-annual basis a report on  
12          the matters described in section 209(a) of the North  
13          Korea Sanctions and Policy Enhancement Act of 2016 (22  
14          U.S.C. 9229(a); relating to persons responsible for know-  
15          ingly engaging in significant activities undermining cyber-  
16          security).

17          (c) BRIEFING.—

18                 (1) IN GENERAL.—The President shall provide  
19                 to Congress on a semi-annual basis a briefing on the  
20                 matters described in paragraphs (1) and (2) of sec-  
21                 tion 318(a) of the Korean Interdiction and Mod-  
22                 ernization of Sanctions Act (Public Law 115–44; re-  
23                 lating to briefing on measures to deny specialized fi-  
24                 nancial messaging services to designated North Ko-  
25                 rean financial institutions).

- 1 (2) FORM.—The briefing required by paragraph
- 2 (1) may be classified.

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
